NEW PARISH COUNCILLORS

A further vacancy arose on the Parish Council following the resignation of Lyn Rickatson after many years of much valued service. The Parish Council is delighted to announce that both vacancies have been filled. The new councillors, who take up their roles officially from December, are Sheila Farmeary of Fangfoss and Bill Burton of Spittal. Both are known to many of you as they are longstanding members of the parish.

COLD CALLING ZONES



Following an increase in calls by door-to-door salesmen, it has been suggested that areas of the parish could be designated 'No Cold Calling Zones'. To do this, East Riding of Yorkshire Council ask residents in the area concerned whether they support the idea. They require almost total agreement before they will go ahead and display a notice similar to that shown.

As you can imagine, getting proof of the required support is quite difficult, so before we put this in train, we would like to know your opinion on the matter. TELEPHONE KIOSKS THREATENED WITH REMOVAL

The Parish Council has received notice via East Riding Council that BT is intending to decommission and potentially remove kiosks in both Bolton and Fangfoss, due to under-use. According to BT records, Bolton kiosk was used 5 times in 12 months and Fangfoss 17 times. There are three options on the table:



- To contest the decision and attempt to keep the kiosks as active telephones;
- To 'adopt' the kiosks (initial cost £1) so that they remain in place but are no longer the responsibility of BT;
- To allow the removal of the kiosks.

Again, the Parish Council would like to hear from residents on this matter. Could you please contact the Clerk, see over, to say which option you prefer, and why. **Please respond by 8 December at the latest.**

DOG FOULING



This issue continues to raise its head in the Parish, where a very small number of irresponsible dog owners fail to comply with the Code. Note to owners: it is not sufficient to bag up dog waste and then leave it by the path or road.

Remember that it is an offence for dog owners to allow their dog to foul public areas and anyone committing this offence can be reported to the **Dog Warden Service on 01482 396301**. They will ask you for: location, time and date, dog owner's name and address and a description of the dog. Calls are in confidence
