## NEWS FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL



### LOCAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

The election date is 7 May, 2015. Anyone wishing to stand for election to the Parish Council must be nominated and seconded by eligible persons in the parish. They must also provide a form assenting to that nomination. The active period for nominations is from the date of publication of the Notice of Election, which is **30 March 2015, to the close of nominations at 4.00pm on Thursday 9 April**. Completed application forms must be delivered by hand to County Hall, Beverley. The necessary application forms and guidance notes can be found online at [www.eastriding.gov.uk](http://www.eastriding.gov.uk) (search for 'parish and town council elections'). Or they are available for download on [www.fangfoss.net](http://www.fangfoss.net). There are seven seats on the Parish Council. Your present councillors, all of whom intend to stand, are: Pamela Broughton, Bill Burton, Sheila Farmeary, Brenda Holmes, Samantha Nelson, Jonathan Oxford and Nigel Rickatson. ### NO COLD CALLING ZONES



A reminder that now the lighter nights are here, the parish council will be beginning the project to introduce 'No cold calling' Zones. This will mean that over the summer months you could receive a letter and form from East Riding asking for your views on the matter, followed by a visit from a parish councillor to collect the completed form. Remember, action can only be taken if *everyone* in the proposed Zone is agreeable, so if you feel strongly that you would not wish for a Zone to be implemented, please contact the Parish Council, as they will otherwise waste time acquiring agreement from other residents.
