ANNUAL VILLAGE MEETING

POCKLINGTON ROAD CLOSURE

The Parish Council has received notice of a road closure affecting traffic into Pocklington. The notice states that the closure will 'prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along part of Yapham Road, junction with Garths End Pocklington, the whole extent of Fangfoss Road, Yapham Mill and part of Main Street junction with Bolton Lane, Bolton, works commencing on the **22**nd **April 2016**. The closure is necessary to enable "carriageway maintenance" work to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order will be valid for 18 months. Work is anticipated to be completed within approximately 7 day.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via: Bolton Lane, Bolton, Newbridge Lane, Yapham, Feoffe Common Lane, Barmby Moor, York Road, Barmby Moor, York Road, Pocklington, Hodsow Lane, Barmby Moor, West Green, Pocklington, Grape Lane, Pocklington and George Street, Pocklington.'
