## NEWS FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL

### ICE & SNOW

We have a number of items relating to snow and ice to pass on.



The first of these is a warning that **Station Road** beyond the 30mph signs can be treacherously slippery and in a recent icy spell, several vehicles left the road as a result. It's also worth mentioning that the turn to Stamford Bridge beyond the Station itself is also a black spot for ice. Please go **very** carefully all along this road. In the meantime, the parish council continue to press East Riding Council to upgrade the road to more frequent gritting.



**HELP NEEDED** A few years ago, the parish acquired two manual gritters and since then these have been operated by volunteers when weather conditions dictate. Taz has been doing a great job in Fangfoss. However, due to changing circumstances, we are now asking for additional volunteers to operate the gritter in Bolton. The machine is stored at the Chapel, along with the salt grit. **If you would be willing to take on some of this responsibility, please contact the clerk.**



Cars parked in St Martin's Close encroaching on the pavement are preventing the full gritting of the walkways. Wherever possible, please pull your vehicle fully on to your property, leaving the pavements with free access for the gritter, not to mention pedestrians with buggies and so forth.

## DEFIBRILLATOR

It's come to our notice that there are people who are not aware that there is a community defibrillator in Fangfoss. This was acquired in 2014, when a couple of training sessions in its use



were run. It is positioned on the side of the Old Chapel on the Pocklington Road just out of Fangfoss – there is a small sign on the opposite verge pointing to it. It

must be stressed that should the need arise, it is possible for anyone to use the machine without training. On ringing 999 you will be given the code to access the machine via a keypad. The machine is constructed to issue voice instructions. We do not leave the code accessible for reasons of possible vandalism, but **if you would like to have it to hand, please email the clerk who will provide it.**



## TELEPHONE KIOSKS UPDATE

The parish council would like to thank those who have made offers of help with restoring the kiosks and put forward ideas for their future use, once the telephones are disabled; we will keep you informed of developments. It appears the adoption process is being handled via East Riding Council, so the timescale on this project is out of our hands. Please do continue to let us have any bright ideas for alternative uses for when we are the adoptive owners of the kiosk!
