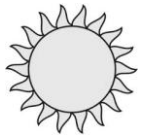




FANGFOSS WITH BOLTON PARISH JUNE/JULY 2014

Defibrillator

Following from our plea for a site to install a defibrillator which had been offered free of charge to the parish by the Ambulance Service, we had a good few responses and thanks go to them all. Of the places on offer, a site was chosen on the side of Harry Postill's workshop, an accessible position with room for a car to pull in. Following installation, a training session was held at school on 17 April, when a dozen people turned up to familiarise themselves with how to use the machine. It must be stressed that should the need arise, it is possible for anyone to use the machine without training. On ringing 999 you will be given the code to access the machine via a keypad. The machine is constructed to issue voice instructions.
