Flytipping - Warning

Did you know you can be held accountable if your waste is disposed of illegally – even if you have hired a firm to take it away for you? Illegal dumping of waste can attract fines of up to £5,000. Ensure that you check the credentials of anyone you employ to dispose of your waste by asking to see their waste carrier number. You can call the Environment Agency on 08708 506506 to ask for a waste carrier validation check.

Hedge trimming

We are now in September so it is safe for households to start trimming hedges without risk to wild birds' nests. As usual, the council has had complaints about encroaching hedges making life difficult for pedestrians. If your hedge borders a footpath or if it is obstructing sightlines on the road, please consider giving it its main cut before the winter to prevent problems for pedestrians and road users.
