Cold calling

The Parish Council would like to thank all those who responded to the survey of parish residents on the subject of Cold Calling. We are pleased to report that we now have the necessary authority from residents to ask East Riding Council to implement 'No Cold Calling' Zones in the parish. The timescale is currently unknown, but from now on will now depend on ERYC.



Safe and Sound Grant

Also on the subject of security, East Riding Council are making available a grant to help with home security measures such as: additional locks for doors and windows; door chains; door viewers; security lights.

Applicants must be homeowners or private sector or Housing Association tenants, should be aged over 60 or disabled, and in receipt of a means tested benefit. For more information, visit the Fangfoss website, where the scheme is advertised at greater length.



Flytipping - Warning

Did you know you can be held accountable if your waste is disposed of illegally – even if you have hired a firm to take it away for you? Illegal dumping of waste can attract fines of up to £5,000. Ensure that you check the credentials of anyone you employ to dispose of your waste by asking to see their waste carrier number. You can call the Environment Agency on 08708 506506 to ask for a waste carrier validation check.
